Can I bring my own furniture?

YES. We encourage you to bring some of your own possessions subject to fire safety and other regulations not being compromised.

Are meals provided?

YES. Breakfast, lunch and dinner plus snacks and tea through the day and at various set times.

Where do we eat and when?

We have two spacious dining rooms with views over the gardens and we hope you would enjoy your meals whilst socialising with your fellow residents.

What about my laundry?

We have an in-house laundry facility which is included in your fee. We ask that all laundry items are clearly labeled. We are unable to provide specialist treatment for delicate items such as silk etc.

Can I have pets?

Whilst we love animals, we have to be mindful of our other residents and so have a policy of not allowing dogs or cats to reside in the home. Pets are always very welcome to visit by agreement of the Manager.

Does a doctor visit?

We have the services and facilities of eight local GP surgeries so hopefully you will be able to retain your own GP and, if not, you will be registered with Kirton Medical Centre which is located near to the home.

Can Friends and family visit?

YES. We are always happy for you to have visitors. We do ask that visitors avoid meal times so as not to intrude on a very important part of the day.

Can I get my hair done regularly?

We have our own visiting hairdresser or you are very welcome to make your own arrangements for someone to visit.

Do you accept Residents whose fees are funded by the local authority?

Yes, but the difference between what the Local Authority funds and Woodlands Court's fees must be made up by a third party - family, for example.

What happens if I change from privately funded to Local authority funded?

An assessment is done on finances following which the Local authority would evaluate their contribution, the resident contribution and any third party top ups.

Mail

Mail is delivered by the Post Office daily except Sunday and public holidays.

Telephone

There is a phone for general use and residents can have their own line installed if they so wish.

E-mail

We are able to provide you with access to emails and also wireless internet. Some residents also enjoy internet link up with their families and friends abroad.

When are the nurses in house?

A nurse is on site 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
